group ~~is~~ often frightened by the drug dealing outside
their homes. We believe a community response
to drug dealing is the right path -- a Working
Group Task Force that can thoughtfully sit down
together & come up with innovative solutions and
ways to provide more services to the drug
addicted & mentally ill on our streets.

We recommend that at least one senior
and person with disabilities be on any Task Force
that may be established. These need to be representatives
from the affected neighborhoods of the TL & SoMa.
