

### Home related crimes

- Residential Robbery: Taking of property by force or fear from the occupant in their residence.
- Residential Burglary: Unlawful entry into any house, room, apartment with intent to commit grand or petit larceny, or commit any other felony.
- Hot Prowl: Unlawful entry into a home when a resident is also there.
- Package Theft: Residents typically report these directly to the retailer or the shipping agent. Package thefts reported to law enforcement are classified as a larceny/theft.






### **Crime Abatement Strategies** Hot Prowl, Home Burglary, Home Robbery

- In November 2017, the Department brought back a citywide Burglary Unit and a citywide Robbery Unit
- Expanded the Burglary Unit in December 2018
- Burglary Unit works with Crime Analysts to link cases together in order to identify suspects and burglary crews which are responsible for various burglary series in and near San Francisco
- Neighborhood Crime Units expanded from pilot stations to every district
- Hot Spot attention through Crime Operation Prevention
- Continue to partner with SF Safe
