Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: Section 1. General Findings.

- (a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 190237 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms this determination.
- (b) On January 16, 2019, the Building Inspection Commission considered this ordinance at a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Charter Section D3.750-5.

Section 2. Findings under Section 17958.7 of the California Health and Safety Code.

All rain water in San Francisco drains to the building drains and sewer. Unusual geology, occasional extremely high local rainfall amounts, and the configuration of the City as a peninsula restrict the installation of separate storm water and sewer systems. House traps not

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only prevent the sewer gases from entering the house or commercial areas but also protect the building from failures in the sewer systems in case of a stoppage, breakage, or the overloading during a storm.

Section 3. Chapter 10 of the Plumbing Code is hereby amended by adding Section 1001.3, to read as follows:

#### **CHAPTER 10 – TRAPS AND INTERCEPTORS**

1001.3 Placement and Minimum Size of Building Traps. The building sewer or building drain shall have a building trap placed as near as possible to the curb line or immediately inside any subsidewalk basement wall under the sidewalk. Trap size shall be a minimum of 4 inches (101.6mm).

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 5. Directions to Clerk. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to forward a copy of this ordinance to the California Building Standards Commission upon final passage.
