

1 [Grant Agreement - San Francisco In-Home Supportive Service Public Authority -
2 Provider Benefits and Administration Contract Approval - Not to Exceed \$255,912,584]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Executive Director of the Human Services Agency to**
4 **execute a grant agreement between the City and County of San Francisco, by and**
5 **through its Human Services Agency, and San Francisco In-Home Supportive Services**
6 **(IHSS) Public Authority for the provision of administration, health, and dental benefits**
7 **to IHSS independent providers for the period of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2022, in**
8 **an amount not to exceed \$255,912,584.**

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10 WHEREAS, The State of California, under Welfare and Institutions Code, Section
11 12300, mandates that all counties provide the In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Program,
12 which provides supportive services to eligible blind, aged, and disabled persons in order to
13 enable these individuals to remain safely in their homes; and

14 WHEREAS, The City And County Of San Francisco, pursuant to California Welfare and
15 Institutions Code, Section 12301.6, has created through legislation the San Francisco In-
16 Home Supportive Services Public Authority to provide for the delivery of In-Home Supportive
17 Services and to be the employer of record for the Independent Providers; and

18 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco also wishes to provide health and
19 dental benefits to the Independent Providers of IHSS; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the grant agreement with
21 the San Francisco In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority to provide administration,
22 health and dental benefits to the IHSS Independent Providers, for the period of July 1, 2019,
23 through June 30, 2022, in the amount of \$255,912,584; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully executed by
2 all parties, the Human Services Agency shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board for
3 inclusion into the official file.
