A "responsive" bidder is one who submits a bid with all required documentation by the due date and time as specified in a solicitation. All eight (8) bids were submitted in a timely manner. A "responsible" bidder is one who meets all of the minimum qualifications and requirements as specified in a solicitation. Seven (7) of the eight (8) bids were deemed responsible as they met all of the minimum qualifications as specified in the solicitation. Given the circumstances of this procurement, OCA is recommending awards only to responsible bidders with the highest evaluation scores in each outreach community and outreach neighborhood.
