We represent Prime Now in connection with an application to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control ("ABC") for a Type 21 Off-Sale General license at their existing fulfillment center in San Francisco. Because the premises is located in a census tract that has an undue concentration of off-sale licenses, we have been advised that a finding of public convenience or necessity is required in accordance with Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4. We respectfully request this Board determine that issuance of this ABC license will serve the public convenience or necessity.

Per the filing instructions, please find additional information regarding the license application.

- 6. <u>ABC application filing</u>: The ABC application was filed on December 10, 2018 with the San Francisco ABC District Office.
- 7. <u>Notice requirements</u>: Notice of the application was posted on the premises for 30 days in compliance with ABC requirements. Likewise, mailings were sent to neighbors within 500 feet and considerations points within 600 feet on January 15, 2019.
- 8. <u>Explanation of PCN request</u>: Please see below for a description of the project and an explanation of how the license will serve the public convenience and necessity for the neighborhood and city of San Francisco.

Project Description – Retail and Delivery

The primary goal in obtaining this license is to allow Prime Now to deliver alcoholic beverages from their San Francisco fulfillment center. The location is an existing fulfillment center where online orders are packaged for delivery. In addition to items currently packaged, sold and delivered from this premises, Prime Now seeks to offer beer, wine, and distilled spirits to customers for delivery or off-sale purchase.

The ABC requires licensees who deliver alcoholic beverages to also be open to the public ("Rule 27"). Maintaining a physical storefront is not Prime Now's goal, so we worked with the ABC to establish minimum storefront requirements needed to obtain a Type 21 license. Those requirements are embodied in Prime Now's standard ABC license conditions, attached hereto. The physical storefront requirements as determined by the ABC to satisfy Rule 27 are minimal.

The retail storefront that will be open to the public will be small (approximately 200 sq. ft.). Although Prime Now sells a variety of grocery and general use consumer goods for delivery, nothing will be available for purchase inside the retail store except for alcoholic beverages. There will be no signs or advertisements outside of the building to attract customers. Alcoholic beverages will not be physically displayed for purchase inside the store. Instead, potential customers will be provided with a catalog of alcoholic beverages available for purchase, most of which will only be available by delivery. There will be a small, curated selection of alcoholic beverages available for customers to purchase and carry out. The inventory available for visitors to purchase will be kept in an area that is not accessible to the public (but covered by the Type 21 license) until ordered by a customer, at which time an employee will remove the alcoholic beverage(s) from inventory. All alcoholic beverage deliveries, whether tendered to the customer in person or sent for delivery, will originate and be sold from the Type 21 licensed premises.

The hours of operation for the retail storefront will be posted at the public entrance. To comply with Rule 27, the retail storefront will be open every day that delivery is offered, for at least half of the hours Prime Now exercises its delivery privilege. Delivery hours are anticipated to occur between 8:00 am – 12:00 am daily. The retail store will only be open to the public for 50% of delivery hours. The proposed retail store hours are 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, daily. Prime Now has no plans to advertise the availability of in-person visits, and therefore expects very few visitors. Based on our experience at other licensed fulfillment centers in California and in other jurisdictions across the United States, customers will prefer to have their purchases delivered.

Prime Now will deliver and sell alcohol in a safe and convenient manner. As with their other licensed fulfillment centers, delivery drivers and in-store employees will require age verification for all alcohol purchases, will promote responsible off-sale alcohol sales, and will operate in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations related to the sale and delivery of alcoholic beverages. Based on the experience at the other licensed locations, we do not expect that adding alcohol for delivery will result in an increase in deliveries from the facility; instead we anticipate that Prime Now members who already order groceries for delivery will now choose to include alcohol with their orders.

Issuance of this License Will Serve Public Convenience or Necessity

Prime Now has a well-established customer base of businesses and individuals who prefer online delivery to in-store shopping. Prime Now members regularly order a wide variety of grocery and household goods and have expressed interest in adding alcoholic beverages to their orders. It is convenient for members

to be able to add alcohol to their regular Prime Now orders and to have these items delivered together. Prime Now offers a larger selection of alcoholic beverages than traditional grocery stores and does so at competitive prices.

This fulfillment center fulfills customer orders throughout San Francisco, offering convenience to residents in all corners of the city. Approving this request will not only serve the public convenience or necessity of the nearby residents, but of the entire city as well.

Prime Now understands the importance of a safe and clean community and will continue working with its neighbors to maintain high standards. Under the conditional license, Prime Now has agreed to maintain the premises free of litter, to not allow alcohol to be consumed on any areas under their control, and to actively monitor the premises in an effort to prevent loitering on or around the premises. They also worked with the neighbors to establish early hours for retail sales (8 am - 4 pm), which satisfies the ABC's requirement under Rule 27 and alleviates the neighbors' concerns regarding late-night alcohol sales.

In January, representatives for Prime Now met with the Dogpatch Neighborhood Association to discuss the license application and any concerns that local residents may have with Prime Now's past and future operations at the premises. They heard concerns about litter and smoking took active measures to address these issues, including increasing patrols and litter cleanup, increasing available trash receptacles, and implementing process changes to reduce littering. In addition, they have been working with community members to ensure an open line of communication so that any questions or concerns raised by the neighbors are addressed in a timely manner.

For the foregoing reasons we respectfully request that the Board make a finding that issuance of Prime Now's Type 21 Off-Sale General license at this location will serve the public convenience or necessity. We represent Prime Now in connection with an application to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control ("ABC") for a Type 21 Off-Sale General license at their existing fulfillment center in San Francisco. Because the premises is located in a census tract that has an undue concentration of off-sale licenses, we have been advised that a finding of public convenience or necessity is required in accordance with Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4. We respectfully request this Board determine that issuance of this ABC license will serve the public convenience or necessity.

The location is an existing fulfillment center where online orders are packaged for delivery. In addition to items currently packaged, sold and delivered from this premises, Prime Now seeks to offer beer, wine, and distilled spirits to customers for delivery or off-sale purchase.

The ABC requires licensees who deliver alcoholic beverages to also be open to the public ("Rule 27"). Maintaining a physical storefront is not Prime Now's goal, so we worked with the ABC to establish minimum storefront requirements needed to obtain a Type 21 license. Those requirements are embodied in Prime Now's standard ABC license conditions, attached hereto. The physical storefront requirements as determined by the ABC to satisfy Rule 27 are minimal.

The retail storefront that will be open to the public will be small (approximately 200 sq. ft.). Although Prime Now sells a variety of grocery and general use consumer goods for delivery, nothing will be available for purchase inside the retail store except for alcoholic beverages. There will be no signs or advertisements outside of the building to attract customers. Alcoholic beverages will not be physically displayed for purchase inside the store. Instead, potential customers will be provided with a catalog of alcoholic beverages available for purchase, most of which will only be available by delivery. There will be a small, curated selection of alcoholic beverages available for customers to purchase and carry out. The inventory available for visitors to purchase will be kept in an area that is not accessible to the public (but covered by the Type 21 license) until ordered by a customer, at which time an employee will remove the alcoholic beverage(s) from inventory. All alcoholic beverage deliveries, whether tendered to the customer in person or sent for delivery, will originate and be sold from the Type 21 licensed premises.

The hours of operation for the retail storefront will be posted at the public entrance. To comply with Rule 27, the retail storefront will be open every day that delivery is offered, for at least half of the hours Prime Now exercises its delivery privilege. Delivery hours are anticipated to occur between 8:00 am – 12:00 am daily. The retail store will only be open to the public for 50% of delivery hours. The proposed retail store hours are 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, daily. Prime Now has no plans to advertise the availability of in-person visits, and therefore expects very few visitors. Based on our experience at other licensed fulfillment centers in California and in other jurisdictions across the United States, customers will prefer to have their purchases delivered.

Prime Now will deliver and sell alcohol in a safe and convenient manner. As with their other licensed fulfillment centers, delivery drivers and in-store employees will require age verification for all alcohol purchases, will promote responsible off-sale alcohol sales, and will operate in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations related to the sale and delivery of alcoholic beverages. Based on the experience at the other licensed locations, we do not expect that adding alcohol for delivery will result in an increase in deliveries from the facility; instead we anticipate that Prime Now members who already order groceries for delivery will now choose to include alcohol with their orders.

Issuance of this License Will Serve Public Convenience or Necessity

Prime Now has a well-established customer base of businesses and individuals who prefer online delivery to in-store shopping. Prime Now members regularly order a wide variety of grocery and household goods and have expressed interest in adding alcoholic beverages to their orders. It is convenient for members

to be able to add alcohol to their regular Prime Now orders and to have these items delivered together. Prime Now offers a larger selection of alcoholic beverages than traditional grocery stores and does so at competitive prices.

This fulfillment center fulfills customer orders throughout San Francisco, offering convenience to residents in all corners of the city. Approving this request will not only serve the public convenience or necessity of the nearby residents, but of the entire city as well.

Prime Now understands the importance of a safe and clean community and will continue working with its neighbors to maintain high standards. Under the conditional license, Prime Now has agreed to maintain the premises free of litter, to not allow alcohol to be consumed on any areas under their control, and to actively monitor the premises in an effort to prevent loitering on or around the premises. They also worked with the neighbors to establish early hours for retail sales (8 am - 4 pm), which satisfies the ABC's requirement under Rule 27 and alleviates the neighbors' concerns regarding late-night alcohol sales.

In January, representatives for Prime Now met with the Dogpatch Neighborhood Association to discuss the license application and any concerns that local residents may have with Prime Now's past and future operations at the premises. They heard concerns about litter and smoking took active measures to address these issues, including increasing patrols and litter cleanup, increasing available trash receptacles, and implementing process changes to reduce littering. In addition, they have been working with community members to ensure an open line of communication so that any questions or concerns raised by the neighbors are addressed in a timely manner.

For the foregoing reasons we respectfully request that the Board make a finding that issuance of Prime Now's Type 21 Off-Sale General license at this location will serve the public convenience or necessity.
