

Mountain Tunnel






Mountain Tunnel Background

Constructed from 1917-1925 and in service since 1925 Conveyance of water from Early Intake to Priest Reservoir Lined and unlined sections

Deterioration noted in the lined tunnel section






Mountain Tunnel Improvements

Project Purpose:

Fix the tunnel. Ensure continued operation for the next 100 years, meet established performance standards, and provide reliable, quality drinking water to the San Francisco Bay Area

Key Facts:

Approx. \$140M construction contract Seven years of construction 2020 - 2026





Scope of Services Agreement No. PRO.0096

- **Pre-Construction Services**—constructability review of the 95% project design and bidding support assistance;
- Construction Contract Administration—safety plan, contract management, risk
 management plan, status meetings, partnering, contractor payments, processing submittals
 and requests for information, claims and dispute review, value engineering review, and
 reports;
- Construction Contracts Management—change management and processing, cost and scheduling analysis and trending;
- Construction Inspection—quality control inspections, record drawing verification, materials testing, and survey controls;
- Construction Project Controls—document and records management, project schedule reviews and management, pre-purchased materials and equipment schedules, construction cost control and forecasting;
- Environmental Construction Compliance Services—environmental oversight, inspections, and specialty monitoring.

Authorize the SFPUC to execute Agreement No. PRO.0096 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for:

Construction Management (CM) Services for the Mountain Tunnel Improvements Project

Not-to-Exceed Amount: \$24.5 Million

Duration: 8 Years (June 2019 to June 2027)
