


Projected Attendance for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019: 1,500,000 Visitors



- Mayor's FY20 General Fund Proposed Budget is a 2%, or \$369,000 <u>decrease</u> from FY19.
- No new FTE's.
- Capital Budget <u>decrease</u> by 60%, or \$1.4 million.

Accessibility Programs and Paid Internships

- Free Saturdays General Admission for SF residents started April 2019
- Free General Admission for all continues on First Tuesdays
- Free General Admission for all youth 17 and under
- A large portion of the de Young, including the **de Youngsters Studio** in the Kimball Education Gallery and the **Tower Observation level**, is free to the public
- All galleries free for K-12 school groups includes programming (curricula, guided tours, art making)
- Free General Admission and reduced Special Exhibition price for all **visitors with disabilities** (and attendant) launched in early 2019
- Free Special Exhibition on six Access Mondays every year includes programming (ASL tours, low vision tours, enhanced wheelchair access)
- Other free General Admission programs through **libraries**, for SNAP card holders, and for families of school groups
