Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor license to Prime Now, LLC, doing business as Amazon Prime Now, located at 888 Tennessee Street (District 10), will not serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and requesting that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control deny the issuance of the license, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4.

WHEREAS, Prime Now, LLC is seeking the issuance of a Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor license for a proposed sales premise doing business as the Amazon Prime Now, located at 888 Tennessee Street (District 10); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed five protests and zero letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and





They also worked with the neighbors to establish early hours for retail sales (8 am -4 pm), which satisfies the ABC's requirement under Rule 27 and alleviates the neighbors' concerns regarding late-night alcohol sales.

In January, representatives for Prime Now met with the Dogpatch Neighborhood Association to discuss the license application and any concerns that local residents may have with Prime Now's past and future operations at the premises. They heard concerns about litter and smoking took active measures to address these issues, including increasing patrols and litter cleanup, increasing available trash receptacles, and implementing process changes to reduce littering. In addition, they have been working with community members to ensure an open line of communication so that any questions or concerns raised by the neighbors are addressed in a timely manner.

For the foregoing reasons we respectfully request that the Board make a finding that issuance of Prime Now's Type 21 Off-Sale General license at this location will serve the public convenience or necessity.
