This letter serves as notification to the Board of Supervisors that San Francisco Public Works intends to use the alternative permitting procedures authorized in Ordinance No. 60-19 for the rehabilitation of 1601 Quesada Ave. San Francisco, CA, 94124. Ordinance No. 60-19 was part of the 2019 shelter crisis packaged and was passed unanimously by the Board of Supervisors on April 2, 2019.

On June 4, 2019, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved Resolution 263-19 authorizing the City to master lease 1601 Quesada Ave. for an initial ten-year term. The Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing plans to use this facility to provide transitional housing to pregnant and postpartum parents experiencing homelessness. The Program will house (17) women and approximately (7) infants, on average. HSH will provide case management, house activities, wellness services, external referrals, and infant services for participating families.
