WHEREAS, Despite progress reducing smoking, tobacco use remains the leading cause of preventable death in the United States, killing more than 480,000 people each year in many forms of cancer, heart disease and respiratory diseases, among other health disorders which are more than AIDS, alcohol, car accidents, illegal drugs, murders and suicides combined; and

WHEREAS, Existing law, the Stop Tobacco Access to Kids Enforcement Act, prohibits a person from selling or otherwise furnishing tobacco products, as defined, to a person under 21 years of age; and

WHEREAS, Existing law prohibits the sale, distribution, or non-sale distribution of tobacco products directly or indirectly to any person under 21 years of age through the United States Postal Service or through any other public or private postal or package delivery service at locations, including, but not limited to, public mailboxes and mailbox stores; and

WHEREAS, Existing law requires that any person selling or distributing or engaging in the non-sale distribution of tobacco products directly to a consumer in the state through the United States Postal Services or any other public or private package delivery service verify

that the purchaser or recipient of the product is 21 years of age by attempting to match the name, address, and date of birth provided by the customer to information contained in records in a database of individuals whose age has been verified to be 21 or older by reference to an appropriate database of government records kept by the distributer, a direct marketing firm, or any other entity; and

WHEREAS, According to the Journal of the American Medical Association, 96% of 15 to 16 year olds were able to find an internet cigarette vendor and place an order in less than 25 minutes, with most completing the order in seven minutes; and

WHEREAS, Studies have shown that nicotine exposure during adolescence can harm the developing brain impacting learning, memory, attention and increasing the addition to other drugs; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 39 will be a critical component in the efforts to restrict sales of tobacco to children and youth by creating a robust age verification process; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No.39 will require tobacco products to be delivered only in a container that is conspicuously labeled with the words "CONTAINS TOBACCO PRODUCTS: SIGNATURE OF PERSON 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY;" and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 39 will also require before completing delivery, a seller, distributor, or non-sale distributor to obtain the signature of a person 21 years of age or older upon the delivery of a tobacco product to a recipient's or purchaser's address; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 39 will permit a recipient and a purchaser to designate an alternative address for delivery if the addresses have been verified; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California Legislature and Governor Gavin Newsom to support and pass California State Senate Bill No. 39; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to send a copy of this resolution to the Governor of the State of California, the California State Assembly, the California State Senate, and California Senator Jerry Hill.
