

1 [General Obligation Bond Election - Affordable Housing - Ballot Question]

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3 **Ordinance authorizing the Controller to modify the ballot question regarding the**
4 **proposed general obligation bond ordinance for the November 5, 2019, ballot (Board of**
5 **Supervisors File No. 190495) to incur \$600,000,000 of bonded indebtedness to finance**
6 **the construction, development, acquisition, improvement, rehabilitation, preservation,**
7 **and repair of affordable housing improvements, and related costs necessary or**
8 **convenient for the foregoing purposes.**

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14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

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16 Section 1. Background.

17 The proposed ordinance in Board of Supervisors File No. 190495 would call and
18 provide for a special election to be held on November 5, 2019, to submit a proposition to the
19 voters to incur up to \$600,000,000 of bonded indebtedness to finance the construction,
20 development, acquisition, improvement, rehabilitation, preservation, and repair of affordable
21 housing improvements, and related costs. Section 8 of that ordinance specifies the language
22 of the ballot question that must appear on the ballot for the November 5, 2019 election.

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24 Section 2. Authorization to Modify Ballot Question.

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1 (a) If the Legislature enacts amendments to California Elections Code Section
2 13119(b) or other sections of the California Elections Code that directly impact the legal
3 requirements for the ballot question set forth in Section 8 of the ordinance in File No. 190495,
4 and those amendments become effective and operative on or before August 12, 2019, the
5 Controller, in consultation with the City Attorney, may modify the ballot question consistent
6 with those amendments. The Controller's modifications must be directly related to, and
7 permitted by, amendments to Elections Code Section 13119(b), or amendments made to
8 related sections of the Elections Code, enacted by the Legislature, and shall not modify the
9 ballot question in any other respects.

10 (b) If the Controller modifies the ballot question as authorized by subsection (a), the
11 Controller shall submit the final ballot question to the Department of Elections by no later than
12 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2019.

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14 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
15 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
16 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
17 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
