Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively three grants totaling \$11,855.40, from the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA); for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

WHEREAS, DPH's Environmental Health Section was awarded three grants from the CDFA, including Petroleum and Weighmaster project (\$8,250), Egg Inspections (\$2,465.40), and Organic Foods (\$1,140) for a total of \$11,855.40 for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA requires the City to comply with the terms of three separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 091042 , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses the Department for three existing positions: two Agricultural Inspectors (Job Class #3450) at 0.05 and 0.06 FTE and an Inspector of Weights and Measures (Job Class #6220) 0.05 FTE for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because CDFA does not allow it; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively three grants from the CDFA in the amount of \$11,855.40; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budgets; and be it
