- WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the mitigated negative 2declaration and heard testimony, the appeal letter, a responses to concerns document 2prepared the by Planning Department the other written records before the Board of 2gupervisors, and heard public testimony in support of and opposed to the adequacy of this 2document; and
- WHEREAS, The mitigated negative declaration files and all correspondence and other 25 ocuments have been made available for review by this Board and the public. These files are

available for public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1650 Mission Street, and are part of the record before this Board by this reference; and 3 WHEREAS, Since the Planning Commission adoption of the mitigated negative declaration, there is no new information of significant that would require a substantial revision to the mitigated negative declaration and necessitate recirculation of said document pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15073.5; now, therefore, be it 7 MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors finds that the contents of the mitigated Regative declaration and the procedures through which it was prepared, publicized, and 9 reviewed complied with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Cal.
