#### **Request:**

 Approve Electronic Monitoring (EM) Program rules and regulations as set forth in the proposed contract with new EM services vendor, Sentinel

#### **Program History**

- Electronic Monitoring program established to provide alternative to incarceration wherein participation is ordered by the Courts
- Fee structure originally based on ability to pay
  - ✓ February 2018 Appellate Court ruling requiring courts to consider ability to pay & non-monetary alternatives when setting bail or release conditions
  - ✓ February 2018 Sheriff Hennessy waived fees for sentenced EM participants
- Monthly program participants increased from 100 to 400 as of May 2019
- New contract awarded to Sentinel after competitive bid process; term begins August 1, 2019


