

1 [Appointments, Children, Youth and Their Families Oversight and Advisory Committee - Julie
2 Roberts-Phung, Winnie Chen, and Yamini Bhatnagar]

3 **Motion appointing Julie Roberts-Phung, term ending July 1, 2020, and Winnie Chen and**
4 **Yamini Bhatnagar, terms ending July 1, 2021, to the Children, Youth and Their Families**
5 **Oversight and Advisory Committee.**

7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Children,
9 Youth and Their Families Oversight and Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of
10 Administrative Code, Sections 2A.233-2A.234, and Charter, Section 16.108-1, for the term
11 specified:

12 Julie Roberts-Phung, seat 9, succeeding Sarah Thompson-Peer, resigned, shall be a
13 person who is a parent or guardian of a child, which child, at the time of the member's
14 appointment for the term, is under the age of 5 years and enrolled in a publicly-subsidized or
15 City-funded program. This member shall have demonstrated a commitment to improving
16 access and quality of services for children, youth and families, for the unexpired portion of a
17 two-year term ending July 1, 2020;

18 Winnie Chen, seat 8, succeeding herself, term expired July 1, 2019, shall be a person
19 who is a parent or guardian of a child, which child is enrolled in kindergarten through 8th grade
20 at the time of the member's appointment for the term. This member shall be from a low-
21 income community or have expertise or substantial experience working to promote the
22 interests of communities of color and shall have demonstrated a commitment to improving
23 access and quality of services for children, youth and families, for the unexpired portion of a
24 two-year term ending July 1, 2021;

1 Yamini Bhatnagar, seat 10, succeeding Eddy Xiao Fei Zheng, term expired July 1,
2 2019, shall be a person with expertise or substantial experience working in the field of children
3 and youth services in communities that are low-income or underserved, for the unexpired
4 portion of a two-year term ending July 1, 2021.
