BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

[Expressing the commitment of the Board to Refund the General Fund Reserve with Revenue from Assembly Bills 1383 and 188]

Resolution expressing the commitment of the Board of Supervisors to backfill reductions in the General Fund Reserve with revenues from Assembly Bills 1383 and 188.

WHEREAS, Board of Supervisors files 091246 and 091202 appropriate funds from the General Fund Reserve to reverse deskilling and layoffs of city health and clerical workers; and,

WHEREAS, The impacted employees provide essential services to City residents and support the Department of Public Health's critical billing and collection functions; and,

WHEREAS, If the City does not act in a timely manner to prevent the deskilling and dismissal of these employees, hundreds of employees and thousands of family members will be negatively impacted; and,

WHEREAS, State Assembly Bills 1383 and 188 are slated to create annual revenues for the City of more than \$30 Million; and,

WHEREAS, The implementation of AB 1383 and AB 188 is dependent on administrative changes at the state and federal levels before those revenues can be transmitted to impacted counties; and,

WHEREAS, In the current fiscal year, FY 09-10, the Board of Supervisors appropriated \$25 Million for the General Fund Reserve; and,

WHEREAS, The adoption of files 091246 and 091202 would significantly reduce available General Fund Reserve; and,

WHEREAS, Having an adequate General Fund Reserve is critical to addressing unanticipated revenue weakness; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors expresses its commitment to appropriate an amount of revenue from AB 1383 and AB 188 to the General Fund Reserve equivalent to that deducted in supplemental appropriations in files 091246 and 091202.
