[Veterans Affairs Commission—Expand Membership & Establish Residency Requirement.]

Ordinance amending Administrative Code Section 5.102, Veterans Affairs Commission, to expand the number of members from 15 to 17 and establish a requirement that members reside in the City and County of San Francisco.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 5.102, to read as follows:

## SEC. 5.102. MEMBERSHIP.

The Commission shall consist of <u>17 15</u>-members. <u>Twelve</u> <u>Eleven of the members shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and <u>five four of the members shall be appointed by the Mayor as follows:</u></u>

- (a) At least three <u>women woman</u>-veterans. <u>The Board of Supervisors shall appoint at least</u> two members pursuant to this subsection; the Mayor shall appoint at least one member pursuant to this subsection.
- (b) A person At least two members who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America and is suffering under who have a physical disability arising from that service, in accordance with the definitions applied in such cases by the Veterans' Administration. The Mayor and Board of Supervisors shall each appoint at least one member pursuant to this subsection.
- (c) All members shall reside in the City and County of San Francisco, effective on the operative date of this section. The Board of Supervisors may only waive this requirement by ordinance.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall calendar the appointment to the Board of Supervisors' newly created seat at the first meeting of the Rules Committee after the effective date of this ordinance.
