SUBJECT: LEGISLATION INTRODUCED

The Board of Supervisors' Land Use and Transportation Committee has received the following proposed legislation, introduced by Supervisor Haney on September 3, 2019:

File No. 190907

Resolution renaming one block of Gilbert Street between Bryant and Brannan Street, which runs parallel to Sixth and Seventh Streets and perpendicular to Bryant and Brannan Streets, to "Jeff Adachi Way."

The proposed legislation officially names an unnamed street, pursuant to San Francisco Public Works Code, Section 423, California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 970.5, 971, 1806, and 5026, and California Government Code, Section 34091.1.

Pursuant to the Code mandates, your department's response to this street naming is required. A hearing for this matter will be scheduled upon receipt of all required department responses.

[Street Name Change - Gilbert Street to Jeff Adachi Way]

WHEREAS, Gilbert Street is the name of the public right-of-way between Bryant and Brannan Streets, and parallel to Sixth and Seventh Streets; and

Resolution renaming one block of Gilbert Street between Bryant and Brannan Street,

WHEREAS. The building that houses the Office of the Public Defender, for the City and County of San Francisco, was built on Seventh Street in 1987, and the back of building faces Gilbert Street; and

WHEREAS, The Public Defender hired Jeff Adachi in 1987, as a Deputy Public Defender assigned; and

WHEREAS, Beginning in 1987 until February 22, 2019, Jeff Adachi walked from the Public Defender's Office back entrance door, out to Gilbert Street to get to the criminal courthouse located at 850 Bryant Street; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi used Gilbert Street as his thoroughfare to get to the criminal courthouse but also as a place to chat with lawyers who were coming back from court that day; and

WHEREAS, In 1999, because of his legendary reputation as an amazing trial lawyer, Jeff Adachi became Chief Attorney of the Public Defender's Office; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi became the elected Public Defender in January 2003 when he took office; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi was elected Public Defender of San Francisco five times, often running unopposed; and

WHEREAS, During his 16 year tenure as Public Defender, Jeff Adachi transformed the Office of the Public Defender into the national model for public defender work; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi became the voice not only in San Francisco but across the country, for racial justice on behalf of the criminally accused; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi, a true believer who spearheaded a rebirth of the fight for racial and social equality, and built a nationwide army to carry the battle forward; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi led by example, trying and winning difficult cases for indigent clients; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi inspired multiple generations of lawyers to follow his example, to be fearless, to never waiver in the struggle for equal justice under the law; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi was a beloved warrior for justice in San Francisco and throughout the country; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi loved the City and County of San Francisco; and WHEREAS, Plaques in honor of Jeff Adachi are being placed in his hometown of Sacramento and Tokyo; and

WHEREAS In the weeks after his death, memorials to him have not ceased; and WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi was more than just a Public Defender, he was a community organizer that championed the fight to protect the vulnerable and marginalized; and WHEREAS, Jeff Adachi had widespread support throughout San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, A candlelight vigil and march organized by the community just days after his passing was attended by over 1200 people; and

WHEREAS, Mayor London Breed hosted a public memorial for Jeff Adachi at City Hall and hundreds of community members and leaders attended to celebrate his life, now therefore, be it

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, in full compliance, with its regulations on street name changes, conducted its investigation on a street name change for Gilbert Street between June 21, 2019 and July 26, 2019; results of such investigation are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 190318, and are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors recognizes that the Department of Public Works, on behalf of the City, has taken all necessary actions to effect this name change, including fully complying with regulations regarding street name changes under California Streets and Highways Code, Section 970.5, which requires posted notice on the street for at least 10 days prior to the Board of Supervisors hearing on this resolution, Public Works Code, Section 423, California Government Code, Section 34091.1, and California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 970.5 and 5026; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby changes one block of Gilbert Street between Bryant and Brannan Street from Gilbert Street to Jeff Adachi Way to enshrine his legacy, and to mark his permanent transformation of the fight for justice on behalf of immigrants and the criminally accused; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Transportation Code, Section 2.2, directs the Municipal Transportation Agency to prepare street signs indicating both the new and former names of the street, with the new name "Jeff Adachi Way in large letters, and the old name "Gilbert Street" in smaller letters above or beneath the new name; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That both of the street names shall remain posted on street signs for five years, and then the street signs shall be replaced with signs indicating only the new street name, "Jeff Adachi Way;" and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That in adopting this legislation, the Board of Supervisors does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over the subject portion of "Gilbert Street" to be known as "Jeff Adachi Way"; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to promptly forward a copy of this Resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with California Streets and Highways ,Code Section 5026, and that the County Surveyor include the new street name on the Official Map of the City.
