Re: Prison to Employment Grant Award

Dear Mr. Arce:

This letter serves as notification that NOVA, as fiscal agent for the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit, has been awarded a Prison to Employment grant from the California State Workforce Development Board (CWDB) in the amount of \$1,797,318 for a term commencing upon the State's official award of the funds (expected in September 2019) through approximately March 31, 2022. The grant is focused on employment and training services for the justice-involved and formerly incarcerated populations.

The City of San Francisco Office of Economic and Workforce Development is a partner in providing services under this grant. Once we have received the grant agreement from the CWDB, NOVA will be developing a contract in the amount of \$387,105 to award funding to OEWD. Please note that this amount will be further divided into two separate funding sources: Regional Implementation and Direct Services for \$231,429; and Regional Supportive Services and Earn and Learn for \$155,676.
