8 **Francisco, et al.; the lawsuit involves dangerous condition of public property and**
9 **inverse condemnation.**

11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:


12 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
13 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled The Roman Catholic Archbishop of
14 San Francisco, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., United States District Court,
15 Case No. 13-cv-2220 MEJ by the payment of \$913,970 by U.S. Pipe & Foundry Company.
16 The lawsuit involves dangerous condition of public property and inverse condemnation.

17 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in United States District Court on
18 April 11, 2013, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs: The Roman
19 Catholic Archbishop Of San Francisco, The Archdiocese Of San Francisco Parish and School
20 Juridic Persons Real Property Support Corporation; Defendants: City and County Of San
21 Francisco and U.S. Pipe & Foundry Company.

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




