

On February 21, 2019, CVS was issued a building permit (BPA No. 2019.02.15.3139) for the Project. Buildout is complete and CVS began operation at the site on May 15, 2019.

CVS now seeks a type-21 off-sale general license from the California Department of Alcohol Beverage Control ("ABC"). CVS has filed an application with ABC for a license transfer. The license would be transferred from the Villa Florence Hotel located at 225 Powell Street (previous License No. 47-515548), to the CVS store at 399 Geary Street (new License No. 599706). Due to the overconcentration of this type of ABC license in this census tract and the Project's location in a high crime reporting district, CVS must obtain a determination by the Board of Supervisors that the public convenience and necessity will be served by the issuance of this license for operations at 399 Geary Street.

The Project will establish a CVS retail store and pharmacy at 399 Geary Street, an existing building at the southeast corner of Geary and Mason Streets. The CVS would occupy approximately 4,320 square feet of ground floor space. The CVS would sell over-the-counter drugs, beauty products and cosmetics, photo finishing, seasonal merchandise, greeting cards, and groceries (such as milk, bread and eggs). The hours of operation are 7 a.m. to 12 a.m. daily.

The CVS will offer a wide variety of convenience goods in the neighborhood. Adding beer, wine and liquor to the offerings of this CVS store would serve the public convenience and necessity of the neighborhood by increasing the variety of goods offered at this location. Area workers,

residents and tourists will have a new store that will provide a convenient, "one-stop" shopping experience.

Adding alcohol to the offerings of this CVS store would also serve the public convenience and necessity by establishing an alcohol retailer that has vast experience with the sale of alcohol and is a responsible retailer with an effective training and corporate-wide management policy for controlling the sale of alcohol. CVS's employee training program, approved by the ABC, must be completed by all employees within 14 days of their hire and before they are permitted to operate the registers. CVS has a zero-tolerance policy – any employee knowingly or recklessly selling any age restricted product to a minor or to an adult purchasing product for a minor is subject to disciplinary action up to termination. Security cameras will be equipped throughout the store and particularly in the area of alcohol sales, which will be monitored by on-site store management, CVS regional and corporate operations, and can be made available to the San Francisco Police Department upon request. The interior store layout for the placement of alcohol products will be designed to allow employees and management to easily monitor activities visually. Further, all checkouts will be equipped with electronic scan detection systems to control the sale of age-restricted products and prompt cashiers to require proper identification before a sale is completed.

Considering CVS's extensive history of alcohol sales in San Francisco, we are also enclosing with this letter a list of proposed conditions to apply to the PCN finding.

For the reasons outlined above, I respectfully request that this letter be forwarded to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board and that the Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination under California Business & Professions Code §23958.4 that the public need or convenience would be served by the issuance of a type-21 off-sale general license to this CVS location.

CVS proposes the following conditions be attached to the alcohol license:

- 1. The hours of operation for the store are currently 7 a.m. to 12 a.m. Customer access to all alcohol will be restricted after 10 p.m. by using any combination of locked cooler cases, gondola covers, and/or physical barricades at the ends of the aisles where the product is located on the sales floor.
- 2. All liquor bottles will be secured and capped to ensure that an individual must make a purchase using a valid identification in order to avoid delinquent behavior.
- 3. No more than 5% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.
- 4. No malt beverage shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 5.7% by volume.
- 5. The sale of single beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited.
- 6. No beer or malt beverages, wine coolers or beer coolers shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
- 7. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles.
- 8. Interior security cameras will be installed within the store and concentrated in the area of alcohol products. These cameras will be monitored during store hours by on-site management, CVS regional and corporate operations, and made available to the SFPD for a minimum of 30 days upon request. External cameras will be installed and operated, focused on the perimeter of the store. Output from these cameras will be shared with the SFPD, upon request.
- 9. Interior store layout for the placement of alcohol products will be designed to allow employees and management to easily monitor activities visually.
- 10. All checkouts will be equipped with electronic scan detection systems to control the sale of age-related products and to prompt cashiers to require proper identification before a sale is completed.

Outreach Summary and Support

CVS Pharmacy has strived to be a good neighbor, beginning an early outreach process in November 2018 by sending a letter to nearby residents (see Enclosure A), notifying them of CVS Pharmacy's intention to seek a Type 21 alcohol license. - Interior security cameras will be installed within the store and concentrated in the area of alcohol products. These cameras will be monitored during store hours by on-site management, CVS regional and corporate operations, and made available to the SFPD for a minimum of 30 days upon request. External cameras will be installed and operated, focused on the perimeter of the store.
- Interior store layout for the placement of alcohol products will be designed to allow employees and management to easily monitor activities visually.
- All checkouts will be equipped with electronic scan detection systems to control the sale of agerelated products and to prompt cashiers to require proper identification before a sale is completed.


