- Catering Facility Cooking (\$1,054)
- Catering Facility No Cooking (\$618)
- Commissary for Cooking (\$1.027)
- Commissary for Mobile Food Facility Servicing (\$618)
- Cooking School (\$618)
- Host Facility (\$824)
- Limited Service Charitable Feeding Operation (\$0)
- Shared Kitchen Complex < 2,000 square feet (\$824)
- Shared Kitchen Complex > 2,000 square feet (\$1,030)

The proposed ordinance would increase the fees for food vending machines from \$177 to \$227 per machine, and the temporary permit for Food Facilities to an amount equivalent to the hourly rate of an Environmental Health Inspector.

The proposed ordinance would define new categories of Food Facilities, and establish an annual permit fee for each category, as follows; • Catering Facility-Cooking (\$1,054); • Catering Facility-Cooking (\$1,057); • Commissary for Mobile Food Facility Servicing (\$618); • Host Facility (\$824); • Limited Service Charitable Feeding Operation (\$0); • Shared Kitchen Complex > 2,000 square feet (\$1,030)

The proposed ordinance would increase the fees for food vending machines from \$177 to \$227 per machine, and the temporary permit for Food Facilities to an amount equivalent to the hourly rate of an Environmental Health Inspector.

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
