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3	Resolution approving a first amendment to the grant agreement between the City and
4	County of San Francisco and the Institute on Aging for the provision of the Community
5	Living Fund, to increase the amount of the grant by \$770,000 for a total amount not to
6	exceed \$10,564,736 to commence November 1, 2019, with no change to the term length
7	of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2021.
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9	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco wishes to provide the Community
10	Living Fund - Case Management and Purchase of Services to San Francisco older adults and
11	adults with disabilities through the non-profit Institute on Aging; and
12	WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency conducted a Request for Proposals for these
13	services in October 2018; and
14	WHEREAS, Institute on Aging submitted a responsive and responsible proposal and
15	was awarded the grant; and
16	WHEREAS, The Aging and Adult Services Commission approved the Community
17	Living Fund Grant to Institute on Aging at its meeting of May 1, 2019; and
18	WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency wishes to provide for the administration of
19	the Public Guardian (PG) Housing Fund which allows for client placement into Assisted Living
20	Facilities (ALF), supportive housing, or other similar types of housing for Public Guardian
21	conservatees who meet the criteria of the Community Living Fund; and
22	WHEREAS, The Aging and Adult Services Commission approved the Public Guardian
23	(PG) Housing Fund grant amendment to the Community Living Fund grant agreement with
24	Institute on Aging at its meeting of October 2, 2019; now, therefore, be it
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1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the grant agreement
2	amendment to Institute on Aging to provide administration of the Public Guardian (PG)
3	Housing Fund within the Community Living Fund grant, during the period of November 1,
4	2019 through June 30, 2021, increasing the amount of the grant by \$770,000 for a total
5	amount not to exceed \$10,564,736; for a total agreement term of July 1, 2019, through June
6	30, 2021; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the grant amendment being fully
8	executed by all parties, the Human Services Agency shall provide the final contract to the
9	Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
