WHEREAS, The Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit, acting as a pass-through agent, granted the Office of Economic and Workforce Development \$387,105 to develop training programs and supportive services for reentry and justice-involved individuals; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That North Valley Consortium (NOVA) Workforce Development Board is the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit fiscal agent for funding from the California Workforce Development Board; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Economic and Workforce Development to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$387,105 from the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit fiscal agent, the North Valley Consortium (NOVA) Workforce Development Board; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Office of Economic and Workforce Development is responsible for the oversight of Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit State funding for workforce development activities in San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Office of Economic and Workforce Development is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
