Dear Ms. Calvillo,

The cost of the proposed ordinance, should it be approved by the voters, is dependent on decisions that the Mayor and Board of Supervisors make through the budget process, as an ordinance cannot bind future Mayors and Boards of Supervisors to provide funding for this or any other purpose. Future costs would likely be significant, subject to these future decisions.

The ordinance would establish Mental Health SF, a program designed to provide access to mental health services, substance use treatment, and psychiatric medications for adult San Francisco residents who are experiencing homelessness, who are uninsured, or who are enrolled in Medi-Cal or Healthy SF and meet certain medical diagnoses. The ordinance establishes a Mental Health Service Center, an Office of Coordinated Care, a Crisis Intervention Street Team, and an Office of Private Insurance Accountability. Additionally, the ordinance establishes a Mental Health Implementation Working Group that would recommend expansion of other mental health and substance use treatment services.

The program established by the ordinance would not be operative until voters approve a tax that would provide additional revenue to fund the program, the City's budget has exceeded the prior fiscal year's budget by 13 percent, or the Board of Supervisors pass a General Fund appropriation to fund the program by a two-thirds vote.

The cost of the program will vary depending on the number of individuals in the specified service populations, their rate of utilization of various services, facility needs, federal and state reimbursement rates, and other factors. My office has not yet concluded its projection of these costs. We will do so prior to submission of this letter to the Department of Elections for inclusion in the Voter Information Pamphlet.
