[Resolution of Intention to Vacate Streets - India Basin]

Resolution declaring the intention of the Board of Supervisors to order the vacation of streets in the India Basin Project site, located generally at Innes Avenue between Griffith Street and Earl Street, along the India Basin shoreline; and setting the Board of Supervisors hearing date of December 10, 2019, for all persons interested in the proposed vacation of said street areas.

WHEREAS, This vacation proceeding for the portions of public streets within the India Basin Project described as follows (collectively, the "Vacation Area") is conducted under the vacation procedures of the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law, (California Streets and Highways Code Sections 8300 et seq.) for portions of Hudson Avenue, Earl Street, Arelious Walker Drive, Fairfax Avenue, Evans Avenue, Galvez Avenue, and Fitch Street identified as Parcels 1 through 16, inclusive on the Public Works ("PW") SUR Map No. 2019-004, dated September 20, 2019 (the "IB SUR Map"); and

WHEREAS, A copy of the IB SUR Map is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 190971, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Section 787(a) of the San Francisco Public Works Code provides that the street vacation procedures for the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of California Streets and Highways Code and such rules and conditions as adopted by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The proposed vacation of the Vacation Area is part of an action to implement the India Basin Project pursuant to a Development Agreement between the City, and India Basin Investment, LLC ("Developer"), which project was approved by the Board of Supervisors by Motion M18-136 and Ordinance Nos. 251-18, 252-18 and 261-18, copies of

which are on file with the Clerk of the Board in File Nos. 180842, 180680, 180681, and 180816, respectively; and

WHEREAS, As provided in the Development Agreement, the City proposes to quitclaim its interest in Parcels 12, 13, 15 and 16 within the Vacation Area as shown on the IB SUR Map to Developer to help facilitate the development of the India Basin Project; and

WHEREAS, As contemplated under that certain Public Trust Exchange Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors, the City proposes to quitclaim its interest in Parcels 4, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11 and 14 within the Vacation Area to the State, which parcels will be re-conveyed to the City, in trust, to be held under Port jurisdiction but incorporated into the India Basin Open Space and managed by the Recreation and Park Department; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That under Sections 8300 et seq. of the California Streets and Highway Code, and Public Works Code Section 787(2), the Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it intends to order the vacation of the Vacation Area as shown on the IB SUR Map No 2019-004; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That notice is hereby given that on December 10, 2019, no earlier than 3:00 P.M. in the Legislative Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation will be heard; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit to PW a certified copy of this resolution, and the Board of Supervisors urges the Director of Public Works and the Clerk of the Board to publish and post this resolution and to give notice of the hearing of such contemplated action in the manner required by law.







 - Vacates 7.5 acres of existing right-of-ways, including some improved streets and other unaccepted or paper streets
 - 3.7 acres of vacated area will be retained by City as open space; 3.8 acres to be conveyed to BUILD as part of mixed-use project
 - Conveyance to be implemented in tandem with Public Trust Exchange Agreement with State Lands Commission, authorized in development agreement
 - City will receive equal or more private land than it conveys






