California

- AB 959: The LGBT Disparities Reduction Act (Asm. Chiu) [2015]
- AB 677: Reducing LGBT Disparities in Education and Employment (Asm. Chiu) [2017]

San Francisco

 Chapter 104 Administrative Code – Collection of Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity Data [2016]



Why Collect SOGI Data?



- **Document disparities** in accessing services
- Identify areas for improvement in current services
- Allocate resources to meet the needs of LGBTQ communities
- Identify and address policy and service gaps
- Lack of data on unique experiences and needs of LGBTQ people

Collection of SOGI Data in San Francisco (2016)

- Collect SOGI data when other demographic data is collected
- Report SOGI data on an annual basis, including:
 - 1. Analysis of SOGI data for Covered Department, contractors and grantees
 - 2. List of programs and services where data demonstrates that LGBTQ individuals are underrepresented and/or underserved
 - 3. Steps planned to address barriers to services




Role of Office of Transgender Initiatives

- Guidance to Covered Departments
- Develop and share best practices on SOGI data collection, implementation, and increasing access for LGBTQ communities
- Compile annual reports, making those available to City Administrator's
 Office and Board of Supervisors
- Trainings for Covered Departments and grantees



Timeline of SOGI in San Francisco



Common Themes

- LGBTQ people are best served by programs that explicitly include and reflect them
- Disparities in needs and access to services between transgender and cisgender LGBQ individuals
- Covered Departments:
 - Capacity limitations
 - Complex data systems
 - Different processes for implementation
 - Training needs



Recommendations

- Coordinated approach across Covered Departments
- Meaningful evaluation of SOGI implementation
- Expand SOGI data collection to all City Departments
- Additional training on LGBTQ issues
- Transparency with public
