RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management; or in his or her absence, the Chief Financial Officer, the Deputy Director, or the Assistant Deputy Director of the Department of Emergency Management; or the General Manager, Assistant General Manager, or Chief Financial Officer of the Bay Area Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) program, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining State and Federal financial assistance provided by the Federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California, as well as provided directly by the State of California, including: the Federal Fiscal Year 2019 UASI Grant, the Federal Fiscal Year 2019 State Homeland Security Grant Program, the 2019 Emergency Management Performance Grant, and the 2019 Local Government Oil Spill Contingency Plan Grant Program.
