The lawsuit involves the sale of products and services to the City by Fidelis in violation of conflict of interest laws.

The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on November 27, 2018, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: plaintiffs City and County of San Francisco and People of the State of California and defendants Fidelis Cybersecurity Inc.; Maarek Zalatimo (aka Mark Zalatimo); Heather Zalatimo; Jeff Jorgenson; and Does One through Ten.
