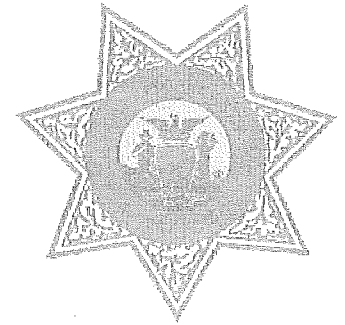
# Property Crime



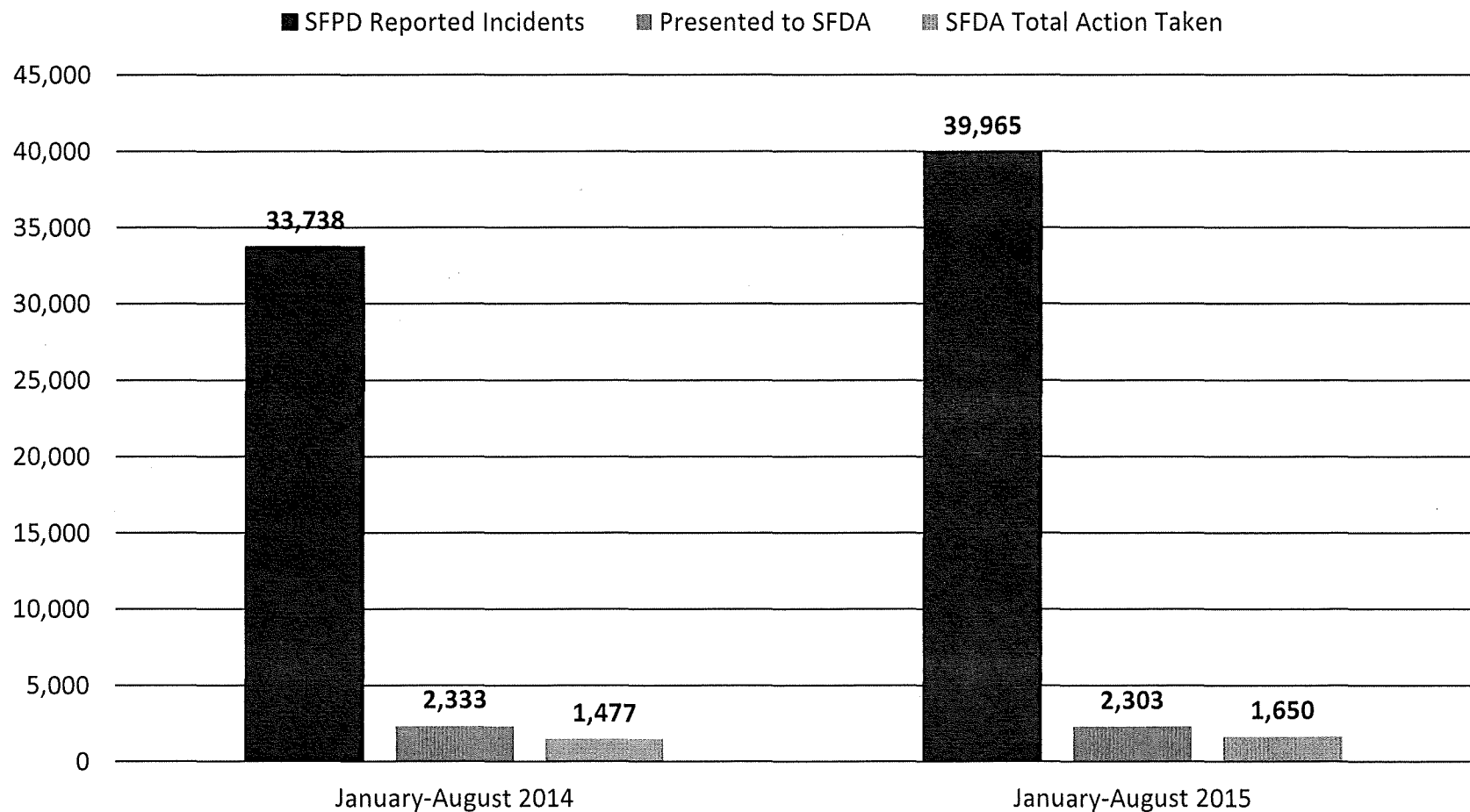
- **Combined, Burglary, Robbery, Larceny/Theft (including Auto Burglary), and Vehicle Theft incidents increased by 8% from 2014 to 2015.**
- The District Attorney's Office prosecuted property cases more often in 2015 than in 2014 (*misdemeanor citation charging data only available through August 2015*).

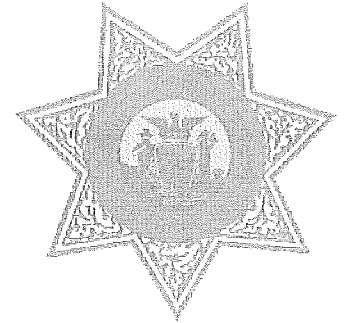

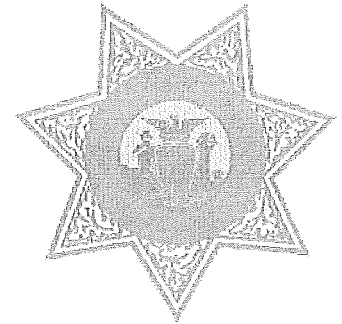
# Auto Burglary



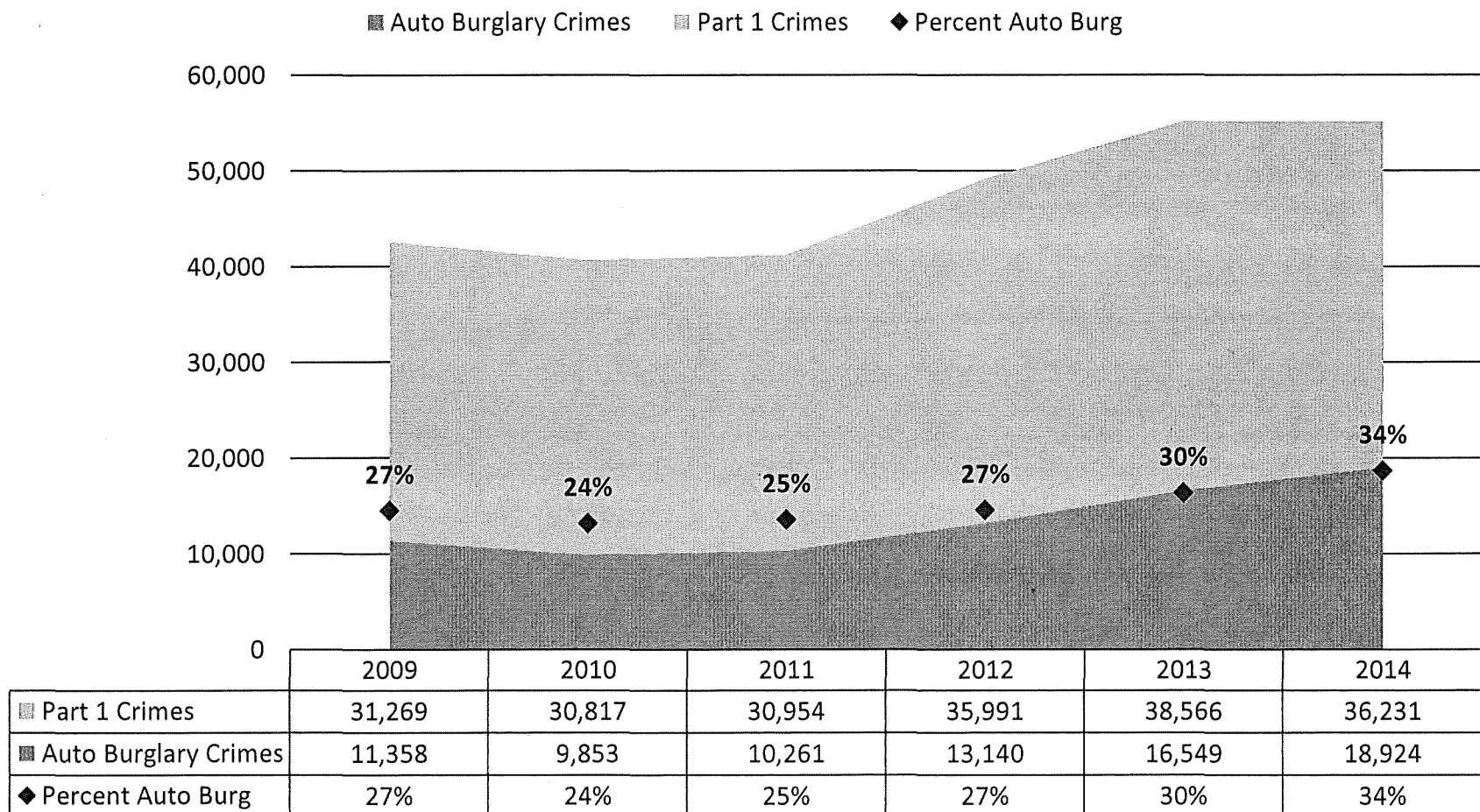
- Our office responded to the Auto Burglary trend by beefing up our Auto crime charging, improving communication with SFPD and providing training to improve the quality of these cases.

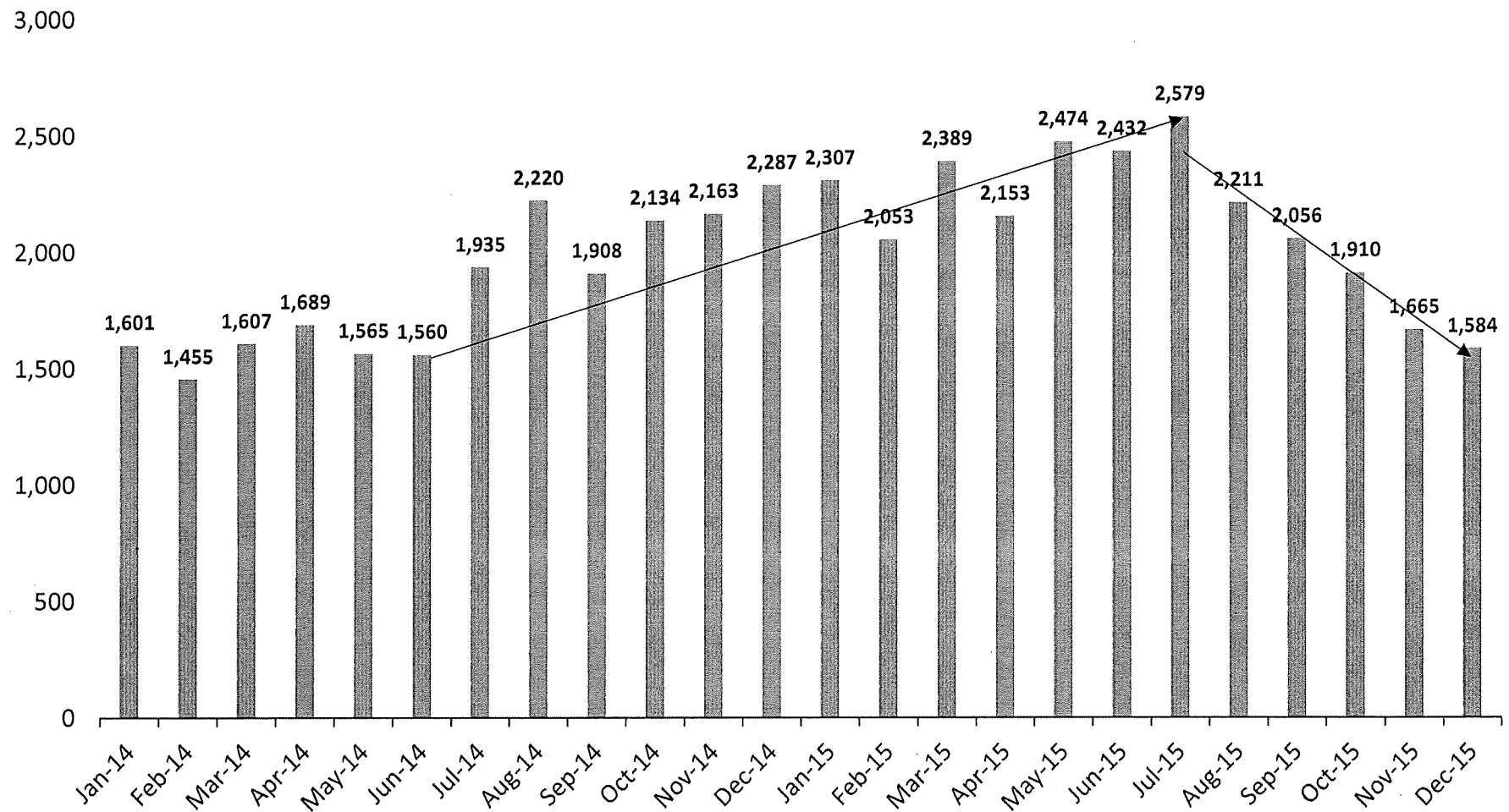
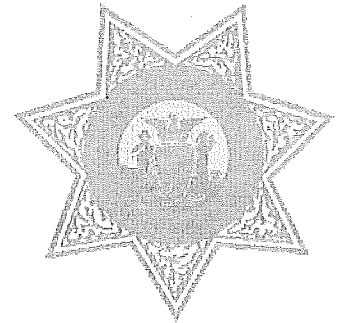
Auto Burglary in San Francisco, 2009-2014 (Source: COMPSTAT)



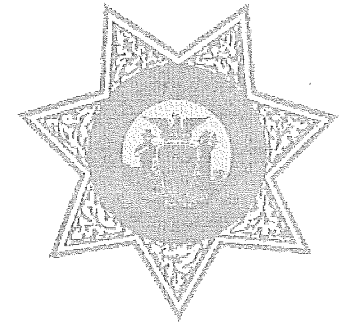

Auto Burglary Incidents, January 2015-December 2015

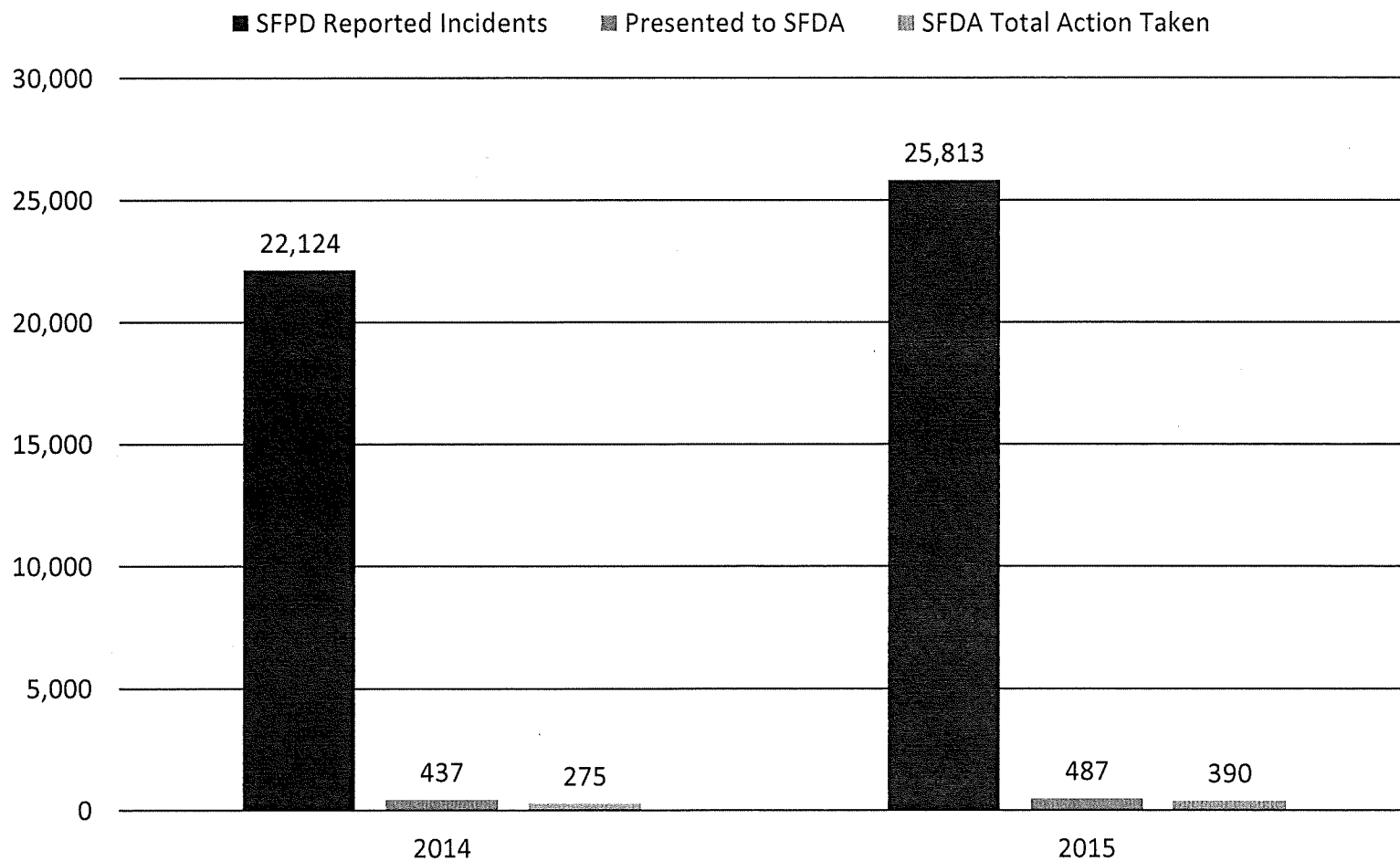

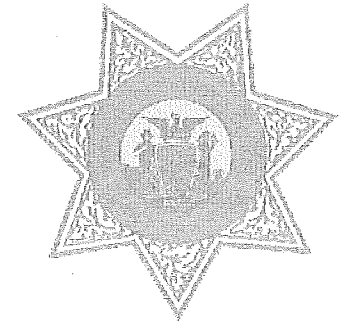

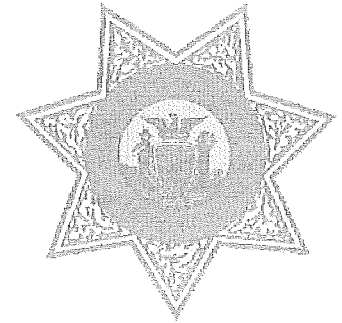

## CITY OF OAKLAND WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

(01/11/2016 - 01/17/2016)

This report is run by the date the crimes occurred. Because both reporting of crimes and data entry can be a month or more behind, not all crimes have been recorded yet. This can create a false reduction in crime in both property and violent crimes. For a more accurate week to week or month to month or current period to same period in a previous year comparison, it is best to compare periods that are between 30 and 60 days prior to the current date. The only certified crime statistics are the UCRs.
