

San Francisco's property crime rate actually declined 6 percent between 2013 and 2014.

Property Crime Rate - San Francisco 2004-2014





Among the five largest cities in California, San Francisco had the highest property crime rate in 2013.

Property Crime Rates - California's Largest Cities 2004-2013




There is an increasing trend for auto burglary, but that increase started in July 2014.







SINCE SEPTEMBER 2014, ARREST RATE HAS DECREASED TO LOWEST RATE SINCE JANUARY 2013




Felony Filings: Filings, Other Action, Total Action Taken



Felony Caseload 2009 Felony Caseload 2014







