WHEREAS, Under Planning Code Section 1004.1, the Board of Supervisors (Board) may by Resolution initiate landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, The draft Excelsior Historic Context Statement mentions 4767-4773 Mission Street (aka. the Royal Baking Company Building), built in 1935, as one of San Francisco's most exuberant examples of Art Deco architecture, as noted by the original green and yellow ceramic tile cladding, three bays of glass block glazing, and sawtooth peaked parapet with fins and speedlines; and

WHEREAS, The property appears to have significance at a local level for association with Italian-American history; and

WHEREAS, The property appears to have significance at a local level for its Art Deco architecture; and.

WHEREAS, 4767-4773 Mission Street appears to have special character and special historical, architectural, and aesthetic interest and value, and may warrant landmark designation; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board hereby initiates landmark designation of properties 4767-4773 Mission Street (aka New Royal Bakery and Metapan Pupuseria), Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6084, Lot No. 021, under Planning Code, Section 1004.1; and, be it
