CIO Opening Remarks

5-Year Roadmap

5-Year Roadmap collaboratively developed with engagement of all stakeholders

- Aligns with criminal justice and broader City goals
- Addresses risks and removes constraints imposed by legacy technology (CABLE3 CMS)
- Manages the dependencies on Superior Court's case management system project
- Establishes pilot for advanced analytics (PowerBI) to support decommissioning and to serve as the foundation for the Data Center of Excellence
- Provides the basis for COIT funding for Year 1 Roadmap funding to decommission CABLE3/CMS; other Roadmap modernization initiatives still require funding





The JUSTIS Roadmap considers both Agency Driven and Shared Initiatives

- Nearly every JUSTIS agency is in the midst of replacing their core case management system.
- Each new system will need to be thoughtfully integrated with JUSTIS
- Significant effort will be required to decommission CABLE/CMS
- Infrastructure and DR issues need to be addressed
- The modernized, real-time JUSTIS data exchange and comprehensive enterprise level reporting and data analytics capability must be implemented





Objectives

JUSTIS Future State Vision

JUSTIS will provide a platform for sharing of timely and accurate information with justice and partner agencies. JUSTIS information sharing capabilities will leverage modern technology to: improve the quality and consistency of criminal and juvenile justice data, enable the sharing of data between JUSTIS agencies in real-time whenever applicable, deploy robust reporting capabilities regarding the complete life cycle of the local criminal justice¹ system, and drive improvements in public safety outcomes through transparency and inter-agency collaboration.


JUSTIS Achieves Efficiencies, Data Sharing & Transparency

- All department case management systems are connected and sending data to the JUSTIS Hub
- JUSTIS is a central data Hub with secure technology for data sharing
- JUSTIS staff provide 24 x 7 data integration support
- JUSTIS is decommissioning CABLE3 while maintaining data operations
- JUSTIS supports cross agency criminal justice initiatives such as:
 - Domestic Violence Lethality Assessments
 - Aggregation and prioritization of criminal justice KPI's, Future Data Sharing, Upcoming Department Large System Implementations and cross-agency Operations
 - Data Driven Dashboards
 - Integration Taxonomy

JUSTIS Programs In Progress

Current Activities

- Office of Justice Technology within DT
- Full CABLE 3 CMS Decommission tied to Courts C-Track Implementation underway.
- Rolling decommission removing department dependencies starting with the Public Defenders Office.
- JUSTIS Modernization with new, secure Power BI Node to handle all CABLE reports conversions and future dashboards.
- Constructing replacement systems for SFPD ID Bureau, District Attorney and Sheriff's Department
- Aggressive schedule to stay in lock-step with SF Courts
