Resolution authorizing the Department of Technology to accept an in-kind gift of consulting services from Google, Inc., for a term of six months to commence upon Board approval, valued at \$750,000.

WHEREAS, The Office of Civic Innovation (OCI) at the Department of Technology matches pro bono private sector talent with departments of the City and County of San Francisco ("City") to address specific policy or operational challenges facing those departments; and

WHEREAS, Under OCI's Civic Bridge program, departments identify service needs that could benefit from innovative solutions and private companies, non-profit organizations and individuals offer to donate consulting services to help departments on these needs; and

WHEREAS, The Civic Bridge program sought assistance for a project to assist the Planning Department and Department of Building Inspection in analyzing the City's preapproval, permitting, and development processes to identify ways to accelerate the production of housing in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Google, Inc. (the Partner) will offer its consulting servicers free of charge in order to help identify and recommend business process improvements to accelerate the production of housing in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Partner has agreed to pilot a project that will be of longer duration and require a greater commitment of staff time than past Civic Bridge projects; and

WHEREAS, Google, Inc. will provide consulting services as part of the Civic Bridge project free of charge as an in-kind gift to the City; and

Mayor Breed; Supervisor Stefani BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, The Donor Agreement with the Partner to provide consulting services on a volunteer basis to the City for a term of six months is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 191186; and

WHEREAS, The consulting services are valued at a total of \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, The gifts do not require amendments to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the in-kind gifts valued at \$750,000, and hereby authorizes, through the Department of Technology Office of Civic Innovation to accept the in-kind gift of consulting services described above, substantially in the form of the donor agreements on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, in File No. 191186, with such changes or modifications, as may be acceptable to the Director of the Department of Technology and the City Attorney and which do not materially increase the obligations and liabilities of the City or reduce the services to the City.
