

1 [Accept and Expend Resolution for Federal Funds.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment (SF Environment) to accept**
4 **and expend funds from the United States Department of Energy's Office of Energy**
5 **Efficiency and Renewable Energy Vehicle Technologies Program (being passed**
6 **through Research and Development Solutions, LLC) in the amount of \$60,000 to**
7 **support San Francisco's Clean Cities Coalition Program and its work related to**
8 **reducing petroleum use and improving air quality in the City and County of San**
9 **Francisco.**

11 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and
12 Renewable Energy Vehicle Technologies Clean Cities Coalition Program has approved the
13 appointment of SF Environment's Clean Vehicles Program Manager to the position of San
14 Francisco Clean Cities Coordinator; and

15 WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and
16 Renewable Energy Vehicle Technologies provides annual supplemental funding (passed
17 through Research and Development Solutions, LLC) to cover activities of the San Francisco
18 Clean Cities Coalition Coordinator; and

19 WHEREAS, The goals and objectives of U.S. Department of Energy's Clean Cities
20 Coalition Program are aligned with the goals and objectives of the City and County of San
21 Francisco related to improving air quality, reducing petroleum usage and reducing global
22 warming emissions; and

23 WHEREAS, Funds from the U.S. Department of Energy's Clean Cities Coalition
24 Program support the Clean Air Program's ongoing efforts to implement the City's
25 Environmental Codes related to air quality and emissions reductions; and

1 WHEREAS, These efforts include activities such as promoting alternative fuel vehicles,
2 facilitating the use of alternative fuels to displace petroleum, and providing outreach and
3 education to local fleet operators; and

4 WHEREAS, the grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$5,455; and

5 WHEREAS, this grant does not require an ASO amendment; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the
7 Department of the Environment to accept and expend \$60,000 from the US Department of
8 Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Vehicle Technologies Clean
9 Cities Coalition Program (being passed through Research and Development Solutions, LLC)
10 to perform work related to improving air quality, reducing petroleum usage and reducing
11 global warming emissions in the City and County of San Francisco.
