[Amending Board Rules of Order- Administration of Oaths and Issuance of Subpoena Duces Tecum]

Motion amending the Board of Supervisors Rules of Order to set forth the process for administration of oaths to individuals testifying before the Board, and to authorize the Government Audit and Oversight Committee to administer oaths and issue subpoenas duces tecum.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby amends Rule 3.3 of the Board of Supervisors Rules of Order by adding Rule 3.3.1 and Rule 3.3.2 to read as follows:

3.3. Committee Authority. Committees shall consider only items which have been referred to them by the President, or by the Board, and which have been posted, published, and noticed. The basic function of each committee is to inquire and to recommend actions to the full Board. Additional committee authority exists only when specifically authorized by ordinance or by the Board. Committees shall provide an opportunity for public comment only with regard to items posted, published, and noticed on their meeting agendas. No Supervisor or combination of Supervisors shall employ or engage the services of any person, or authorize or incur any charge, debt or liability against the City unless authority first shall have been given by the Board or is provided by law.

3.3.1. Administration of Oaths at Government Audit and Oversight Committee Meetings. By oral motion adopted by a majority of the members of the Government Audit & Oversight Committee, the Committee may instruct the Committee Clerk to administer an oath to any person testifying before the Government Audit & Oversight Committee, excluding City employees testifying in their official capacity and persons testifying during public comment. Upon adoption of such a motion, the Committee Clerk shall administer an oath to the person testifying before the Government Audit & Oversight Committee. Any testimony following such

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an oath shall be given under penalty of perjury. In addition to the authority granted by this Rule, the Board by written motion may authorize any standing committee to administer oaths, consistent with Charter, Section 16.114.

3.3.2. Issuance of Subpoena Duces Tecum by the Government Audit & Oversight Committee. By oral motion adopted by a majority of the members of the Government Audit & Oversight Committee, the Committee may instruct the Committee Clerk to issue a subpoena duces tecum to individuals whose testimony is sought in public hearings on File with the Clerk of the Board, with the request to appear at the Government Audit & Oversight Committee and respond to questions and produce any related materials in their possession on the hearing subject matter; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby adds Rule 4.27 to the Board of Supervisors Rules of Order as follows:

4.27 Administration of Oaths. By oral motion adopted by a majority of the members of the Board, the Board may instruct the Clerk to administer an oath to any person testifying before the Board, excluding City employees testifying in their official capacity and persons testifying during public comment. Under adoption of such a motion, the Clerk of the Board shall administer an oath to the person testifying before the Board. Any testimony following such an oath shall be given under penalty of perjury.
