Why the Census Matters

Power, voice and funding

Every person counted impacts funding, political representation, and allocation of public services and infrastructure for the next 10 years.

Challenges

- ✓ The Census has been politicized
- ✓ Historic Undercount
- ✓ Fear: anti-immigrant rhetoric & harm done with citizenship question
- ✓ Accessibility, Digital & Language Barriers
- Underfunding & Undertesting
- ✓ Privacy & Cybersecurity Risks
- Declining Trust In Government

What is SF Counts?

A coordinated grassroots effort with a broad network of community, arts, civic, labor, education, government and faith-based organizations to ensure that every person in San Francisco is included and accurately counted in the 2020 Census.



You may have heard a lot about this 2020 Census thing.

It kicks off in March and it's a big deal.

The Census is a 9-question confidential survey that takes 10 minutes to complete. When you fill out the Census, each person in your household (including you) brings \$20,000 into your community over the next ten years. Everyone has the right to safely participate. Yes, everyone—citizen or not—even bables count. And despite what you may have heard, there is no citizenship question on the 2020 Census.
