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1	[Concurring in Proclamation of Local Emergency - Coronavirus Response]
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3	Motion concurring in the February 25, 2020, proclamation by Mayor London N. Breed
4	declaring the existence of a local emergency in connection with preparations the City
5	and County of San Francisco is making in response to the serious and imminent threat
6	of an outbreak of the novel coronavirus COVID-19 ("COVID-19") and compliance with
7	the Center for Disease Control's guidance regarding responding to COVID-19, and
8	concurring in the actions taken to meet the emergency.
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10	WHEREAS, On February 25, 2020, Mayor London N. Breed declared a local
11	emergency to exist in connection with preparations the City is making to address the spread
12	of the novel coronavirus COVID-19 ("COVID-19"); and
13	WHEREAS, The Mayor has transmitted a copy of that Proclamation Declaring the
14	Existence of a Local Emergency to the Board of Supervisors, and such copy is on file with the
15	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200228; and
16	WHEREAS, Government Code Sections 8550 et seq. and Charter Section 3.100
17	provide for the concurrence by members of the Board of Supervisors in such emergency
18	declaration and in action taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and
19	WHEREAS, Public health officials have detected COVID-19 in 33 countries around the
20	world, and the number of cases continues to increase; the Center for Disease Control ("CDC")
21	has determined that COVID-19 presents a serious and imminent threat, requiring coordination
22	among state and local health departments to ensure readiness for potential health impacts
23	associated with the virus; and
24	WHEREAS, CDC has issued guidance to local health departments including the San

Francisco Department of Public Health concerning risk assessment, monitoring

communicable disease threats, and public health management of people exposed to COVID-
19; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Public Health has determined that DPH cannot comply with CDC's guidance and respond to the serious and imminent threat to public health without immediate action beyond the City's ordinary capabilities, including directing personnel and resources from other City departments to assist with the ongoing and developing threat of COVID-19; the Mayor has directed City officers and employees to take steps required by the Director Public Health to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and to prevent or alleviate illness or death due to the virus; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has found the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril justify and require a proclamation of the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has directed the head of each department and agency to observe his or her proper relationship in the command structure of the Incident Command System, and be responsive to the orders and requests of the Lead Department designated to exercise supervision over his or her department during the course of this emergency; and

WHEREAS, This declaration of a local emergency shall be deemed to continue until it is terminated by the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors; all departments of the City and County of San Francisco are strictly enjoined to cooperate with the requests for material and personnel resources by the City's Incident Command System staff located in the Emergency Operations Center; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the Proclamation by the Mayor Declaring the Existence of Local Emergency issued on February 25, 2020, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency.

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
