[Accept and Expend Grant] - Retroactive - Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) - Recruitment and Training - \$365,700]

Resolution retroactively authorizing the Sheriff's Department of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend \$365,700 from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) to assist local agencies for recruitment and training of corrections and probations personnel adherence to standards established by BSCC from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, The Standards and Training for Corrections (STC) Program operates under BSCC (formally the Corrections Standards Authority) was established on July 1, 1980, under the California Penal Code (Part 3, Title 7, Chapter 5, Sections 6024 through 6036); the STC Program provides a standardized, state-coordinated local corrections selection and training program; the intent of the program is to improve the skills and raise the level of competency of local corrections and probations officers; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and WHEREAS, The grant does not require matching fund; and

WHEREAS, The terms of the legislation establishing the program do not allow indirect or administrative costs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Sheriff's Department is hereby directed to accept and expend in the amount of \$365,700 from BSCC for criminal justice purposes; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the funds received hereunder shall be used to reimburse training expenditures not reimbursed by the Peace Officers Standards and Training Program (POST); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Sheriff of the San Francisco Sheriff Office is here by authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform, in the name of City and County of San Francisco, all applications, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary to secure the STC grant funds and implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application.
