Resolution Condemning Californians for Population Stabilization's (CAPS) TV and Radio Ads and Urging Local Media Outlets Not to Air Racist and Anti-Immigrant Ads

WHEREAS, Californians for Population Stabilization (CAPS) has been airing the TV ad, "Ecological Footprint" in which they pose the question to the public "Concerned about America's huge carbon footprint? Then you should be concerned about immigration"; and,

WHEREAS, CAPS has purchased time on local television station KRON-4 which has aired the ad in the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, CAPS, an anti-immigrant organization is scapegoating immigrants by blaming California's environmental problems and global warming on immigrants; and,

WHEREAS, Their ads declare without basis that "Immigrants produce four times more carbon emissions in the U.S. than in their home country" and that "Immigration will drive the population increase equal to the entire American west in just 30 years"; and,

WHEREAS, CAPS is using global warming and environmental issues as strategies to promote their anti-immigrant sentiments and ideas but claim to work on preserving the quality of life for all Californians by stabilizing the population; and,

WHEREAS, CAPS also asserts that "Reducing immigration won't change global warming but it is part of the solution"; and,

WHEREAS, Groups such as CAPS are fixated on blaming immigration for our environmental issues when the central problem lies in U.S consumption patterns; and,

WHEREAS, Writer Andrea Christina Nill stated in her article dated October 22, 2009 and published in the LA Progressive, that Americans consume energy and are dependent on non-renewable fossil fuels such as automobiles; and

WHEREAS, Nill's article also states that immigrants are doing what most planners urge us to do: walk, bike, or bus; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco, a city built by the diversity of its residents, opposes fear mongering, xenophobia, racism, and anti-immigrant sentiments; and,

WHEREAS, Community activists, as well as local immigrant rights organizations, have all condemned CAPS's anti-immigration ads; therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby condemn the language used in CAPS's ads and urge local media outlets not to air racist and anti-immigrant attack ads.
