12	with the Mayor's Local Emergency Declaration and the actions taken to meet the emergency;

14	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Health Officer issued a State of Public Health
15	Emergency on March 6, 2020, pursuant to Section 101080 of the California Health and Safety
16	Code to respond to the growing threat of COVID-19 locally; and
17	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Health Officer issued a Shelter in Place Order on
18	March 16, 2020, taking further actions to contain the spread of COVID-19; and
19	WHEREAS, The Governor of California issued a Stay at Home order for the State of
20	California on March 19, 2020; and
21	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to
22	schedule standing hearings at every Tuesday that the Board of Supervisors has a regular
23	meeting for the members of the Board of Supervisors to convene and to sit as a Committee of
24	the Whole at 3:00 p.m. to discuss informational updates related to the COVID-19 Health
25	Emergency Response with relevant City agencies and subject matter experts.

MOVED, That the President of the Board of Supervisors, in consultation with Members off the Board of Supervisors, will establish a schedule to determine specific topics that the weekly Committee of the Whole hearings will address while prioritizing issues of urgency and public interest; and invite the appropriate staff and experts for each hearing.
