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3	Resolution urging the inclusion of additional data sets in the San Francisco COVID-19
4	Data Tracker for sexual orientation and gender identity, and additional congregate
5	residential facilities.
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7	WHEREAS, On April 7, 2020, the City and County of San Francisco published the San
8	Francisco COVID-19 Data Tracker (the "Data Tracker"); and
9	WHEREAS, On April 28, 2020, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopted a
10	Resolution urging the disclosure of additional data sets related to the well-being of homeless
11	San Franciscans and residents of Single Room Occupancy hotels, authored by Supervisor
12	Peskin, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200381, which is hereby
13	declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and
14	WHEREAS, Data specific to all varieties of congregate facilities is not now being made
15	public in San Francisco; and
16	WHEREAS, Such data is needed to inform residents, families, staff members, state
17	and local health departments when a change or increase in interventions is needed, and can
18	help lower the risk of residents or staff becoming infected with COVID-19 and dying of it; and
19	WHEREAS, Residents of congregate facilities are at increased risk of COVID-19
20	transmission, and are disproportionately members of groups already vulnerable to more
21	severe infections and health risks; and
22	WHEREAS, Lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, and intersex ("LGBTQI") people may be
23	particularly vulnerable during the COVID-19 pandemic as members of populations already
24	vulnerable to disparate health outcomes; and

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1	WHEREAS, Complete Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity ("SOGI") data is not
2	currently being reported in the Data Tracker; now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the inclusion of additional SOGI data
4	in the Data Tracker, specifically sexual orientation demographic information for Patients Under
5	Investigation ("PUIs") and confirmed positive COVID-19 cases; and, be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges that the total number of
7	PUIs and the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases also be included in the Data
8	Tracker for the following types of congregate residential facilities including the name of the
9	facility:

24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That in urging the disclosure of these additional data sets, the
25	Board of Supervisors is mindful of privacy restrictions on the release of certain data sets and

1	urges compliance with all local, state and federal laws protecting individual privacy rights of
2	San Francisco's residents and visitors.
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
