15	Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and implements the First
16	Amendment to the 2019-2022 Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the City and
17	County of San Francisco and the Service Employees International Union, Local 1021
18	(Miscellaneous), to updated the night shift differential provisions to include additional
19	classifications and provide a one-time payment to employees in specified classifications.
20	The First Amendment to the MOU so implemented is on file with the Clerk of the Board
21	of Supervisors in Board File No. 200483.

23	Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Human
24	Resources to make non-substantive ministerial or administrative corrections to the MOU.

1	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
2	Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance
3	unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of
4	Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
