12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	
14	Section 1. Article XVII of Chapter 5 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
15	revising Sections 5.17-5 and 5.17-7, to read as follows:
16	
17	SEC. 5.17-5. POWERS AND DUTIES.
18	(a) The general purpose of the Advisory Committee shall be to provide a regular
19	venue for interested community stakeholders and the general public to discuss any proposed
20	development on the Site, and to ask questions of and give input to City officers and staff and
21	to developers, once selected.
22	(b) The Advisory Committee shall provide feedback on what development objectives
23	should be included in the Request for Proposals to be issued by the City for development of
24	the Site. This feedback shall include, but need not be limited to, the following issues: (1)
25	Development economics and housing affordability; (2) Transportation, including site access,

1	parking, and congestion management; (3) Open space and other community benefits; (4)
2	Interactions with City College; and (5) Good neighbor policies to serve existing residents and
3	small businesses around the Site. The Advisory Committee shall also provide feedback and collect
4	community input during the project's development entitlement process, and shall serve as a liaison to
5	the project sponsors after the development entitlements have been issued on issues of community
6	concern, including, but not limited to, the project's construction schedule, the impact of construction on
7	transportation, and noise generated by construction.
8	* * * *
9	
10	SEC. 5.17-7. SUNSET.
11	The Board of Supervisors and Mayor intend the Advisory Committee to last until
12	development entitlements have been issued for the SiteJuly 1, 2021. Accordingly, this Article XVII
13	shall expire by operation of law, and the Advisory Committee shall terminate on July 1, 2021,
14	five years after the effective date of Ordinance No. 45-15 establishing the Advisory Committee,
15	provided that the Board of Supervisors may extend the expiration date by ordinance. After the
16	expiration of the Advisory Committee, the City Attorney shall cause this Article to be removed
17	from the Administrative Code. Notwithstanding Rule 2.21 of the Board of Supervisors Rules of
18	Order, which provides that advisory bodies created by the Board should sunset within three
19	years, the Board intends the Advisory Committee to exist for longer than three years.
20	
21	Section 2. Effective Date -: <u>Retroactivity.</u>
22	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
23	when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
24	sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
25	Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

1	(b) This ordinance shall be retroactive to May 8, 2020. It is the intent of the Board of
2	Supervisors that, during the period between May 8, 2020, and the effective date of this
3	ordinance, the Advisory Committee shall continue to operate without interruption, and that the
4	incumbent members of the Advisory Committee shall continue to hold their seats without
5	reappointment unless removed in accordance with Section 5.17-4 of the Administrative Code.
6	
7	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
8	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
9	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
10	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
11	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
12	the official title of the ordinance.

[Administrative Code - Balboa Reservoir Community Advisory Committee]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to extend the sunset date for the Balboa Reservoir Community Advisory Committee ("Advisory Committee") from May 8, 2020 to July 1, 2021; and to require the Advisory Committee to provide community input after development entitlements have been issued.

Existing Law

Article XVII of Chapter 5 of the Administrative Code establishes the Balboa Reservoir Community Advisory Committee (the "Advisory Committee"). The purpose of the Advisory Committee is to provide a regular venue for interested community stakeholders and the general public to discuss the development of land located off of Ocean and Phelan Avenues in Balboa Park, and to ask questions of and give input to City officers and staff and to developers. Under Article XVII, the Advisory Committee will sunset on May 8, 2020.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would extend the sunset date of the Advisory Committee from May 8, 2020 until July 1, 2021, and would charge the Advisory Committee with serving as a liaison to the project sponsors after the development entitlements have been issued on issues of community concern, including, but not limited to, the project's construction schedule, the impact of construction on transportation, and noise generated by construction. The proposed ordinance would be retroactive to May 8, 2020 to reflect the Board's intent that the Advisory Committee continue to operate without interruption between that date and the effective date of the proposed ordinance, and that the incumbent members of the Advisory Committee continue to hold their seats without reappointment.

Background

This Legislative Digest has been revised to reflect action taken in the Rules Committee on May 11, 2020 to amend the ordinance to add a retroactivity provision.
