18	WHEREAS, On April 3, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-0096, the Airport Commission
19	approved Modification No. 1 to the Agreement to exercise the first of three two-year extension
20	options for a term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2020, to increase the contract amount by
21	\$15,803,224 for a new total contract not to exceed amount of \$27,353,224, and to revise the
22	scope of services and reimbursable charges; and
23	WHEREAS, On May 22, 2018, by Resolution No. 160-18, the Board of Supervisors
24	approved the Agreement under Charter, Section 9.118; and
