| 17 | Office of Community Investment and Infrastructure (OCII) v. San Francisco Museum of |
| 18 | Modern Art, Yerba Buena Arts & Events, and Does 1-20, San Francisco Superior Court, Case |
| 19 | No. CGC-17-558438 by the payment of \$1.2 million by defendants San Francisco Museum of |
| 20 | Modern Art ("SFMOMA") and Yerba Buena Arts & Events ("YBA&E") in exchange for a |
| 21 | release from the City. The lawsuit involves damage to the Crescent Pool at the Yerba Buena |
| 22 | Gardens Plaza allegedly caused by an SFMOMA fundraiser. |
