9	Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County of San Francisco ("City") and		
10	the San Francisco Firefighters Union, Local 798 ("Local 798"); and		
11	WHEREAS, On September 27, 2018, Local 798, expanded the grievance to include		
12	other Fire Department employees regularly assigned to work at the Department of Emergency		
13	Management, including Carlton Biscevic, Cristobal Guajardo Jr., Lawrence Jew, Robert		
14	Lopez, Paul Mangiola, Daniel Molloy, Regina Morley, Marc Pearson, Janeen Pirosko, Tina		
15	Seibert, and Shannon Stabile ("Grievants"); and		
16	WHEREAS, The grievance (ERD No. 31-18-3429) involves alleged failure to properly		
17	compensate Grievants for overtime under the MOU; and		
18	WHEREAS, The Fire Department and Fire Commission recommend settlement of the		
19	grievance by payment of \$68,420.98;		
20	WHEREAS, The Human Resources Director recommends settlement of the grievance		
21	by payment of \$68,420.98; now, therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle		
23	and compromise the grievance by payment of \$68,420.98 (subject to all applicable taxes,		
24	deductions and other withholdings) as follows: Carlton Biscevic (\$2,102.98), Cristobal
