14	WHEREAS, On March 11, 2020 and March 13, 2020, the Mayor took additional steps
15	to meet the local emergency by issuing the First and Second Supplements to the
16	Proclamation, and on March 24, 2020, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the actions
17	taken by the Mayor in those Supplements; the First and Second Supplements and the Board's
18	concurring motion are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200294;
19	and
20	WHEREAS, On March 17, 2020, March 18, 2020, and March 23, 2020, the Mayor took
21	additional steps to meet the local emergency by issuing the Third, Fourth, and Fifth
22	Supplements to the Proclamation, and on March 31, 2020, the Board of Supervisors
23	concurred in the actions taken by the Mayor in those Supplements; the Third, Fourth, and

Fifth Supplements and the Board's concurring motion are on file with the Clerk of the Board of

Supervisors in File No. 200326; and

1	WHEREAS, On March 27, 2020 and March 31 2020, the Mayor took additional steps to
2	meet the local emergency by issuing the Sixth and Seventh Supplements to the Proclamation
3	and on April 7, 2020, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the actions taken in those
4	Supplements; the Sixth and Seventh Supplements to the Proclamation and the Board's
5	concurring motion are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200352;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, On April 1, 2020, the Mayor took additional steps to meet the local
8	emergency by issuing the Eighth Supplement to the Proclamation, and on April 14, 2020, the
9	Board of Supervisors concurred in the actions taken in that Supplement; the Eighth
10	Supplement to the Proclamation and the Board's concurring motion are on file with the Clerk
11	of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200369; and
12	WHEREAS, On April 10, 2020, and April 14, 2020, the Mayor took additional steps to
13	meet the emergency by issuing the Ninth and Tenth Supplements to the Proclamation, and on
14	April 21, 2020, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the actions taken in those Supplements;
15	the Ninth and Tenth Supplements and the Board's concurring motion are on file with the Clerk

17	WHEREAS, On April 23, 2020, the Mayor took additional steps to meet the emergency

5	WHEREAS ON June 29, 2020, the Mayor took additional steps to meet the emergency
6	by issuing the Twenty-first Supplement to the Proclamation, ordering three actions to meet the
7	emergency; the Twenty-first Supplement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
8	in Board File No. 200714;
9	WHEREAS, Government Code, Sections 8550 et seq., and Charter, Section 3.100,
10	provide for the concurrence by members of the Board of Supervisors in such emergency
11	declaration and in action taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and now, therefore, be it
12	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the following actions taken by the
13	Mayor to meet the local emergency included in the Mayor's Twenty-first Supplement to the
14	Proclamation, dated June 29, 2020, as those actions are described in full in the Twenty-first
15	Supplement and summarized as follows:
16	Action #1: Waiving barriers and fees under the Planning Code to allow K-12
17	schools to temporarily expand their space to comply with physical distancing requirements
18	and/or accommodate increases in enrollment due to closures of other schools.
19	Action #2: Extending the paid furlough program for City employees through
20	July 31, 2020.
21	Action #3: Extending for an additional 30 days through August 10, 2020, the
22	moratorium on San Francisco Public Utility Commission water and power shutoffs and the
23	imposition of late penalties.

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
