

3	Resolution declaring the commitment of the City and County of San Francisco to hiring	
4	a transformative leader for the County's Veterans Service Office, to safeguard the	
5	public health of the veterans in the City and County of San Francisco during the	
6	existence of a local emergency due to the ongoing spread of the novel coronavirus	
7	COVID-19.

9	WHEREAS, California Military and Veterans Code, Section 970, provides each county	
10	within the state the appointment of a County Veterans Service Officer; and	
11	WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Section 5.108.A-1, establishes the County Veterans	
12	Service Officer under the purview of the Director of Administrative Services; and	
13	WHEREAS, The Director of Administrative Services shall nominate for appointment by	
14	the Board of Supervisors candidates who are qualified to serve as the County Veterans	
15	Service Officer; and	
16	WHEREAS, Pursuant to California Military and Veterans Code, Section 970, such	
17	Officer shall be a veteran; and	
18	WHEREAS, The position of County Veterans Service Officer has been vacant for over	
19	a year; and	
20	WHEREAS, On February 25, 2020, the San Francisco Veterans Affairs Commission	
21	wrote the City Administrator to formally request the Interim Appointment of a County Veterans	
22	Service Officer; and	
23	WHEREAS, On February 25, 2020, the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco	
24	issued the Proclamation Declaring the Existence of a Local Emergency, under Sections 8550	
25	of the Government Code, Section 3.100(13) of the Charter, and Chapter 7 of the San	

1 Francisco Administrative Code, establishing the existence of an emergency within the City 2 and County of San Francisco due to the ongoing spread of the novel coronavirus COVID-19; 3 and 4 WHEREAS, Ten percent of COVID-19-related deaths in San Francisco have come 5 from the veteran population; and 6 WHEREAS, There are now over 1,300 confirmed cases of COVID-19 reported in San 7 Francisco: and 8 WHEREAS, Greater coordination is necessary to track and monitor the number of 9 veterans who are currently infected with COVID-19 or have recovered from COVID-19; and 10 WHEREAS, Greater coordination is necessary to track and monitor the number of 11 veterans who are HUD-VASH eligible and expedite their pathway into housing; and 12 WHEREAS, Greater coordination and program outreach is necessary to maximize the 13 resources available to veterans between local, state, and federal levels; and 14 WHEREAS, A dedicated liaison is necessary to coordinate response efforts with the 15 City and County of San Francisco's Emergency Operations Center; and 16 WHEREAS, A dedicated liaison is necessary to coordinate efforts between City and 17 County of San Francisco's agencies and local nonprofit entities capable of aiding veterans in 18 the community; and WHEREAS, A dedicated liaison is necessary to coordinate efforts between veterans' 19 20 organizations, staff, and volunteers; and 21 WHEREAS, A dedicated liaison will be necessary to coordinate with the recovery 22 efforts of the City and County of San Francisco and state and federal agencies; and 23 WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Section 5.108.A-2, delineates the powers and duties 24 of the County Veterans Service Officer; and 25

WHEREAS, The County Veterans Service Officer is responsible for the overall
 operation of the County's Veterans Services Office, coordinating with public information
 officers, and coordinating veterans' services throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, The County Veterans Service Officer is responsible for developing and
administering program budgets, preparing budget requests and forecasts, and monitoring and
approving expenditures, in coordination with departmental and City management; and

WHEREAS, The County Veterans Service Officer is responsible for the monitoring,
selection, training, and evaluation of administrative personnel and Veterans Claims
Representatives; and

WHEREAS, The Veterans Claims Representatives under the supervision of the County Veterans Service Officer are currently understaffed, experiencing a sizeable increase in the needs of veterans and their families, and anticipating an even larger increase in the needs of veterans and their families after the end of the COVID-19 emergency; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco is committed to providing the veterans in the community with much more than basic intake and referral services from the County's Veterans Services Office; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco is committed to 18 hiring a transformative leader for the County's Veterans Service Office, who will recruit top 19 talent for its Veterans Claims Representatives, lead a major drive to enroll veterans into 20 healthcare and disability services to attract additional federal funds to San Francisco's VA 21 Medical Center through the resource allocation system, leverage the Office to seek innovative 22 grant opportunities, and coordinate across local, state, and federal levels to bring in the 23 resources needed to house every veteran in San Francisco and find them a path forward into 24 our community; and, be it
